### **Chefs Corner by Chef Paul Roberts**

Thanksgiving is right around the corner. To help with your Holiday turkey, here is a simple brine that I have used for many years. Enjoy!

- 2 Gallons water
- 3 Cups Apple cider vinegar
- 2 Cups brown sugar
- 1 Cup Kosher Salt
- 3 Tablespoons Whole Black Pepper
- 5 Bay Leaves
- 5 Cloves Garlic, crushed
- 4 Springs Rosemary
- Peel of 3 oranges, in large strips

Combine all ingredients in a large, 5-gallon pot (big enough to contain your turkey) and bring to a boil until sugar & salt dissolves, which takes a few minutes. Remove from the heat and let cool completely. Add the uncooked turkey. Put a plate or two on top of turkey so it's completely submerged. Let it sit in the brine for at least 8 hours but not more than 24 hours. No need to salt the turkey before roasting. Remove turkey from brine, pat dry, and roast according.

### GOLF COURSE MAINTENANCE

The month of October is the final growing month of the year and we help it along by doing a fertilizer application with a 26-0-0 with 14% sulfur to strengthen up the Bermuda grass before it goes dormant. This helps the fairways and roughs have a nice cushion to them for good playing conditions and to better resist the cart traffic during the winter time. As the Bermuda grass starts to get dormant, we will apply a pigment application to the fairways which is a green colorant to help keep them green throughout the cold frosty mornings. Also look for the greens to get firmer and faster when that first frost hits!
