**GOLF COURSE MAINTENANCE**

In the month of September the maintenance team started preparing the golf course for the winter weather. We started with the greens by double verti-cutting and then aerating with a ½" hollow tine to pull out cores. Afterwards, we top dressed with a 30 grade silica sand which we dragged into the holes with a cocoa mat. The tee boxes were also scalped down, reducing the Bermuda grass, and then we used a drop spreader to seed the inside edges of the tees and a rotary spreader to seed the remainder of the tee box. We also did a wrap around the green collars by using a drop spreader as well. All of this is done to help the cool season rye grass come in stronger and healthier, which is why we also must limit the traffic on it with the specified tee boxes.



You will also notice some significant changes with the practice range. To start, we have installed a sun shade on the north side of the range to provide some relief from the heat. We will see how this handles the elements of the winter before potentially expanding it more. Also on the range we have added some definition to the green complexes with bunkers. A layer of seed was also placed on the greens and tee. We look forward to it popping with some color in the next few weeks. Finally, new range balls have arrived. Come on out and get your game fine tuned!
